

Who can I turn to?

Aim	For young people to realise who they can turn to for help and advice
Duration	Approx. 15-30 Min
Number of participants	5-20
Difficulty	medium
Conditions	-
Material	Paper and pens; various case scenarios on paper; sticky coloured dots (green, yellow, red)

Preparation

Prepare various case scenarios (see examples on the right).

Write various places to go and people to turn to down on cards: friends, parents, teachers, drop-in centres, police, etc.

Description

In small groups discuss each scenario, who the participants would turn to in such a case and how serious it is.

Afterwards, each scenario should be marked with a coloured dot: red = to be taken very seriously, green = no big issue. The participants can allocate the cards to the case scenarios according to who they would turn to (parents, police, etc.). There will be different opinions, which is okay - these should be discussed.
