

## chain letters

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| <b>Aim</b>                    | Correct handling of fearsome chain letters                                 |
| <b>Duration</b>               | 10 - 40 min  |
| <b>Number of participants</b> | 2-15   |
| <b>Difficulty</b>             | middle   |
| <b>Conditions</b>             | -  |
| <b>Material</b>               | Children's smartphones including WhatsApp chain letters, a poster and pens |

### Preparation

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### Description

The children form a circle and have their mobile phones and the received WhatsApp chain letters. Each child reads a letter one after the other. Each chain letter and the category of the letter are noted on the poster. The categories are named together. If chain letters or categories are repeated, this is also noted. This process continues until the children lose patience.

At the end consideration is given to how to proceed or react to the chain letters or categories found.

Possible categories of chain letters:

- ... "I'll come tonight and kill you."
- ... your mother dies in three years."
- ... you'll see how unpopular you are."
